A Note From Our Lead Pastor

One of our values here at Parkland is Christlikeness. We are passionate about becoming more like Jesus, He is our example and our aim in life. Paul argues in Ephesians 4, that God has equipped the church for every good work, “until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of God’s Son, growing into maturity with a stature measured by Christ’s fullness.

Then we will no longer be little children, tossed by the waves and blown around by every wind of teaching, by human cunning with cleverness in the techniques of deceit. But speaking the truth in love, let us grow in every way into him who is the head—Christ.” But how do we cultivate Christlikeness in our lives? What does it look like to be more like Jesus? Those are the questions we will attempt to answer in our upcoming series on Galatians.

Here, Paul writes to the church in Galatia urging them not to depart from the gospel, but instead to mature by cultivating the fruit of the Spirit. So, we will look at the whole book, spending several weeks investigating this fruit and learning how to develop them in ourselves and others. It’s my prayer that we wouldn’t be satisfied or complacent but press on toward Christlikeness that God enables in us by the power of His Spirit. May it truly be said of us that Parkland people are Jesus people.
