A Note From Our Lead Pastor

We find ourselves in the middle of our 10-week, “Who’s Your One?” emphasis. By now, I certainly hope you’ve identified your “one” and begun to pray for them by name every day.

But the next step takes a bit more courage. We must intentionally engage that person with the gospel. Some of you interact with your “one” every day. They’re co-workers, family members, neighbors, or friends. Others are a little more distant and require a greater effort to interact with them. Regardless of our distance, we must move beyond the simple “nice” interactions to gospel conversations. This doesn’t mean we will give a full gospel presentation, but it should mean we intentionally direct the conversation to spiritual things.

The best way to do this is by asking good questions. How can I pray for you right now? Have you ever stopped to think about what happens after we die? In your opinion, what does it take for a person to get to heaven? Can I share with you how God has been working in my life lately? All are open doors for gospel conversations, but there is no “one size fits all” approach. Find the “in” that works best for you. Whatever the case, may we constantly strive to intentionally engage others with the good news of Jesus! The gospel came to you because it was headed to someone else!

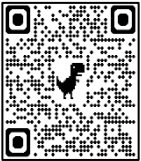
