A Note From Our Lead Pastor

"How do I know God's will for my life?" If I've asked it once, I've asked 100 times and so have you. As believers, we are uniquely sensitive to what God wants from our lives. This is a natural response to the salvation we have in Christ. We know that we are saved from sin but also saved FOR good works. The question on our minds is, which good works? If we aren't careful, it can become an anxious compulsion rather than a trusting obedience. We think to ourselves, there must only be one right answer in every circumstance, and if I don't get it exactly right, God will be displeased with me.

But what if we get the wrong answer because we are asking the wrong question? This is where *Experiencing God* begins. Over the next several months we will be participating in this timeless discipleship course on Wednesday nights. But even if you can't make it on Wednesdays, this is an important topic to consider. Instead of asking, "what is God's will for my life?" we must ask, "What is God's will?" You see, our question is usually centered on me, not on God. We need to orient ourselves toward Him and His will first and then reorient our life around His will.

God is at work around you every single day, His will is being accomplished. Will we join Him where He is at work? This is the fundamental truth we must internalize; God is at work and I can and must join Him in His work. This week, try to actively shift your focus. Find where the Lord is at work and join Him there. We don't have to dream up things for Him to do through us, we simply must join Him in the work He is already doing in our workplace, our home, and our world.


