A Letter From Our Pastor

Parkland Family,

The greatest strength of the church is in the many, not the few. We can do far more together, when we collaborate, than we can apart. It’s why we partner with fellow Southern Baptists to send missionaries around the world, educate thousands of students in our 6 seminaries, and plant churches in cities all over North America.

But that’s not just true when we partner with other churches, it’s true within the bounds of Parkland as well. We do incredible good when we work together. We connect with our community when we work together to put on our Kids Basketball league each Fall. We teach God’s Word effectively when we work together to build and maintain a strong Sunday School. We join forces to accomplish every task before us.

Right now, the task that needs our collaboration feels far more physical than spiritual. We desperately need to come together to repave our parking lot. Unfortunately, nothing is forever, not even pavement, and every 30 years or so, we must get a fresh start. But while the parking lot is physical, I would argue that there is a spiritual aspect to all of this.

If you show me how you do the little things, I'll tell you how you do everything. That’s the moral of the story Jesus tells, known as the Parable of the Talents. In the story, a wealthy man gave three servants each a number of talents, or a sum of money, according to their ability. To one he gave five, another two, and still another only one talent. Then the master went on a long trip. The servants with five and two talents invest that money they had been given to make more that they present to the master when he returns, and they are rewarded. But the final servant, afraid of what the master will do if he loses his talent, buries it in the ground. When the master returns, he finds the servant hasn’t put his talent to work at all, and he is cast out.

Sometimes we are led to believe that stewardship is burying our talent in the ground. As long as we don’t lose it, we’ve been faithful. But that’s simply not what Jesus says. Using what God has given us well, that’s stewardship. We can’t bury it in the ground, it’s meant to multiply for the good of the Kingdom!

So too, this parking lot project is an opportunity to exercise the talents God has given us. We can, and we must work together to accomplish this goal. That means each of us must do our part as church members. Each of us is responsible to give and collaborate to see this project to the end. I want to invite each of you to join me on Sunday, June 2 to do just that. On that day, Pave the Way Sunday, we will give a special offering for the parking lot. Right now, we have raised over \$150,000, and need approximately \$80,000 more. Friends, God has given us the talents, it’s our job not to bury them in the ground, and instead put them to work.

How we do the little things, like paving a parking lot, is how we will do everything. Don’t you want to present our best to the Lord in faith? When we are faithful with the little, God will give us much.
