ANGER (Men & Women’s Groups) : *Good & Angry* by David Powlison. Together we’ll reframe the problem of anger through an in-depth exploration of God’s anger and our own. Full of practical help on how we should redeem anger, irritation, complaining and bitterness as we ask the question: Can you be both good and angry?

THEOLOGY/MODERN CHRISTIAN CLASSIC: *Knowing God* by J.I. Packer. Explore what it means to truly know God personally. HISTORICAL/MEMOIR: *Through the Gates of Splendor* by Elizabeth Elliot. Read the true story of five young missionaries who ventured deep into the Ecuadorian jungle with a desire to bring the gospel to an isolated tribe. Filled with sincerity, courage, and sacrifice, this powerful book challenges readers to consider the cost of obedience to God through one of the most compelling missionary stories of the twentieth century.

CHILDREN’S THEATRICAL AUDIO BOOK: (Grades 1st – 5th) *The Wanderer* by A.L.O.E. This dramatic and thought-provoking story follows the restless journey of a young man searching for purpose, freedom, and lasting peace.
